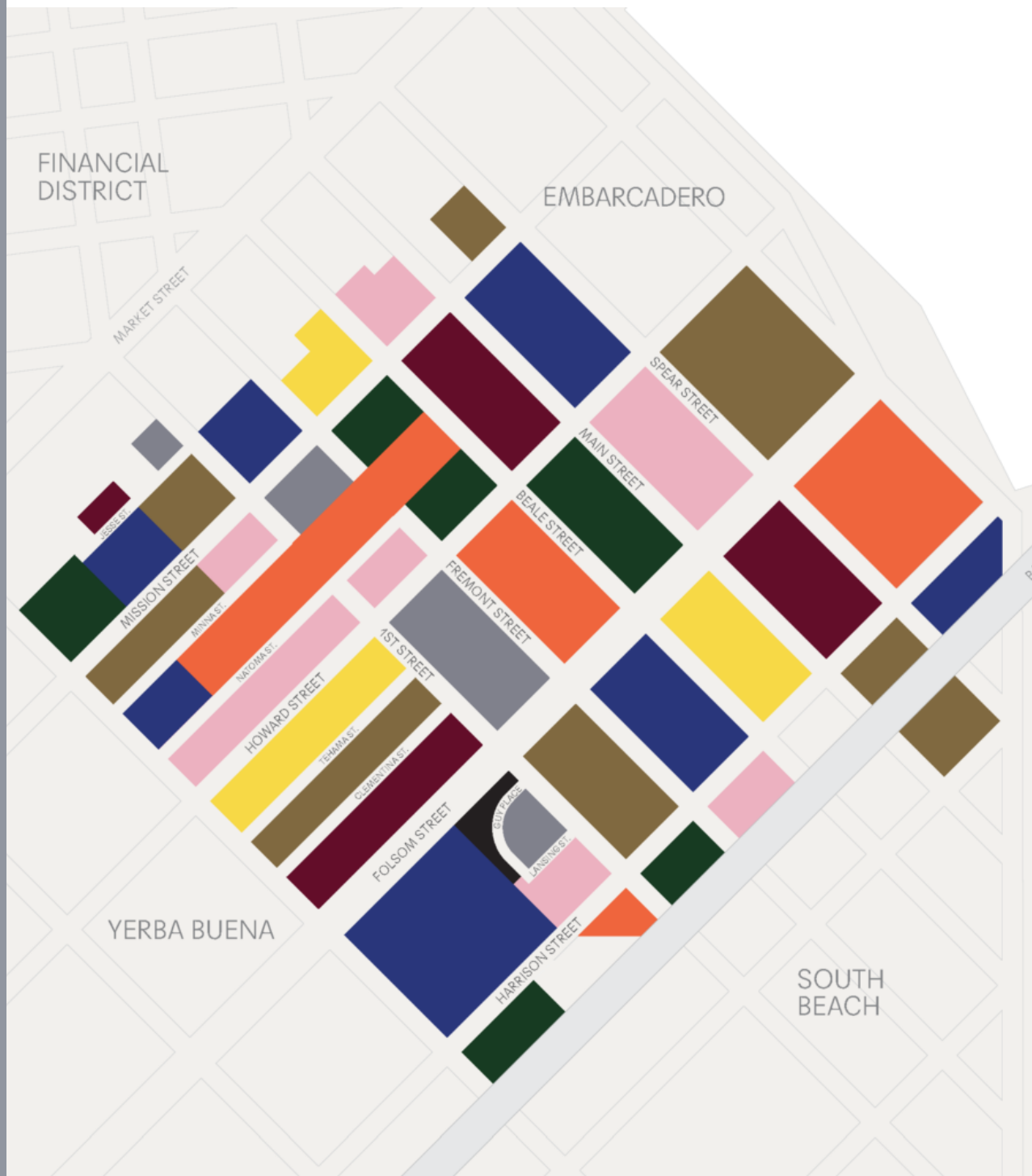


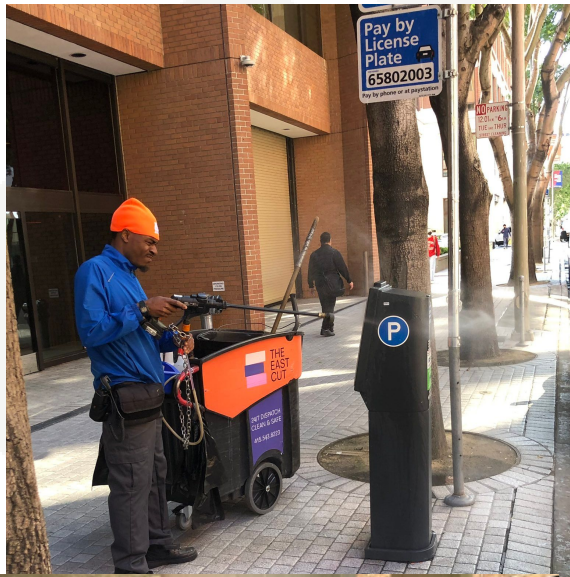

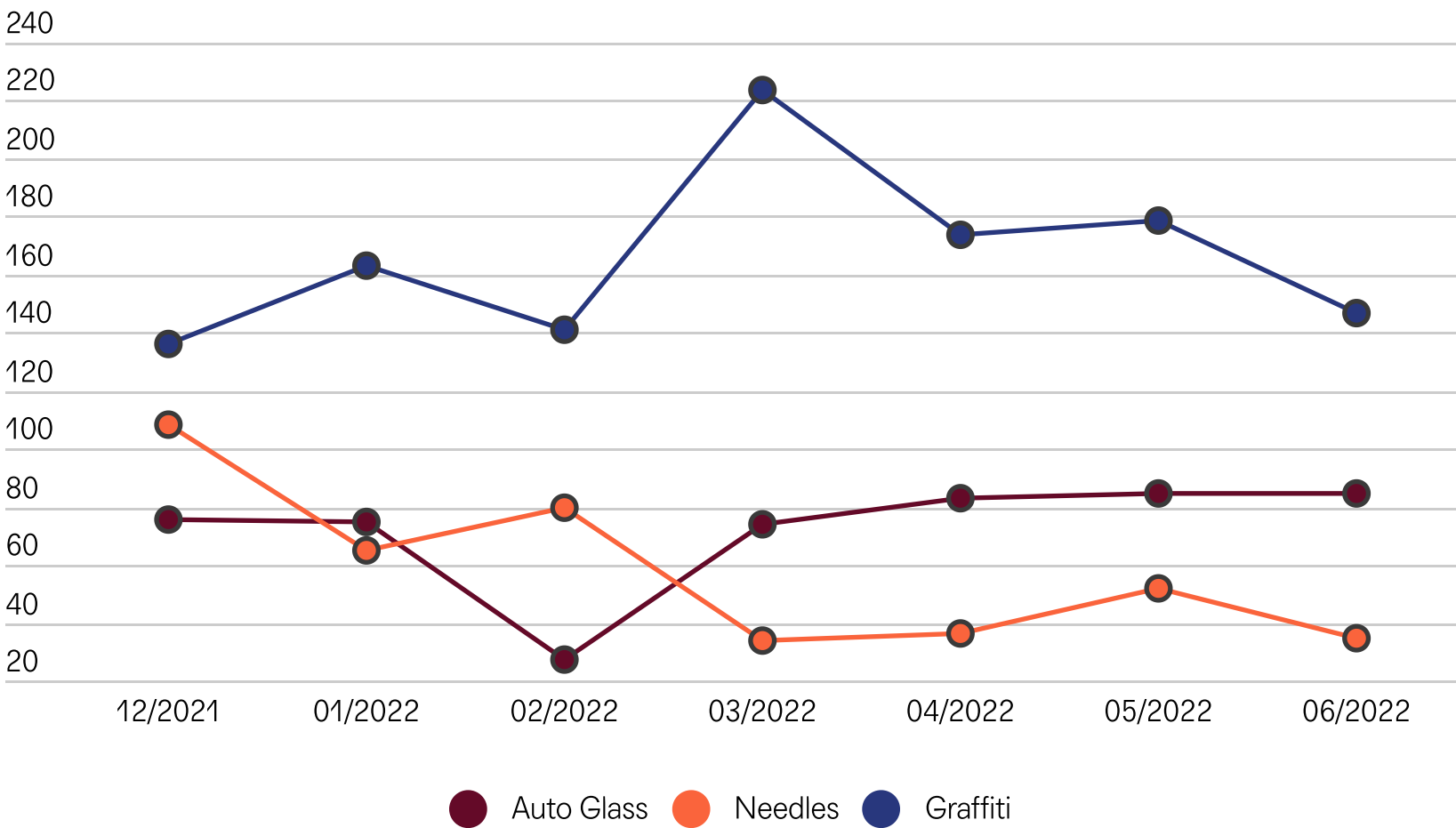

East Cut Dispatcher Rene went out of her way to assist with a gentleman who locked his keys in his car. Rene called her triple A insurance and had a technician come out to help.



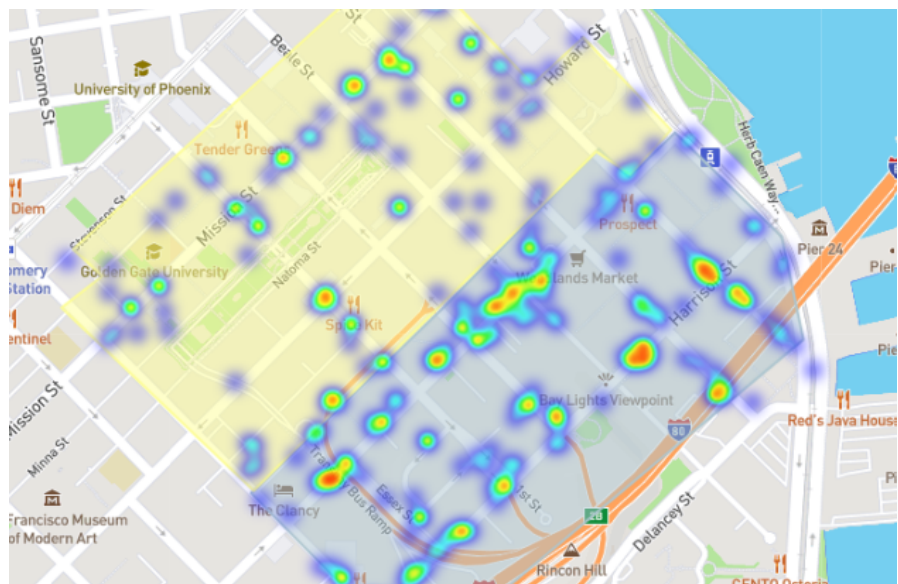

This map shows all of the feces removed by The East Cut cleaning team. The areas in red require more clean-up.

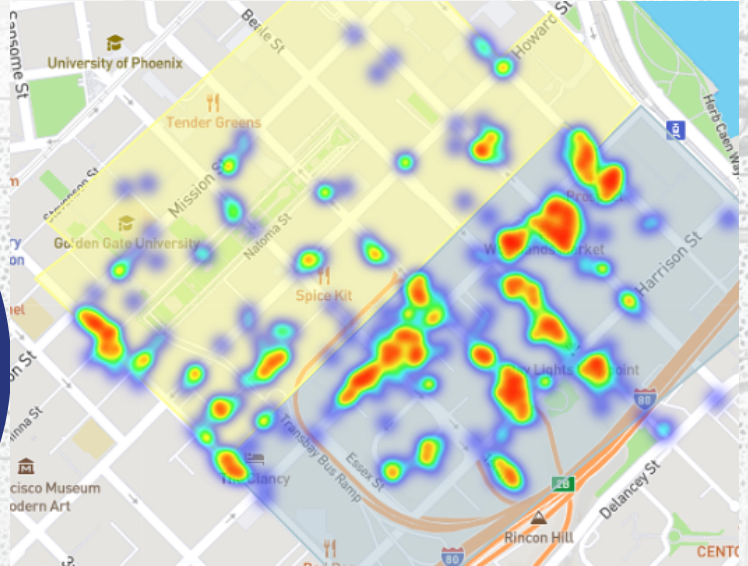

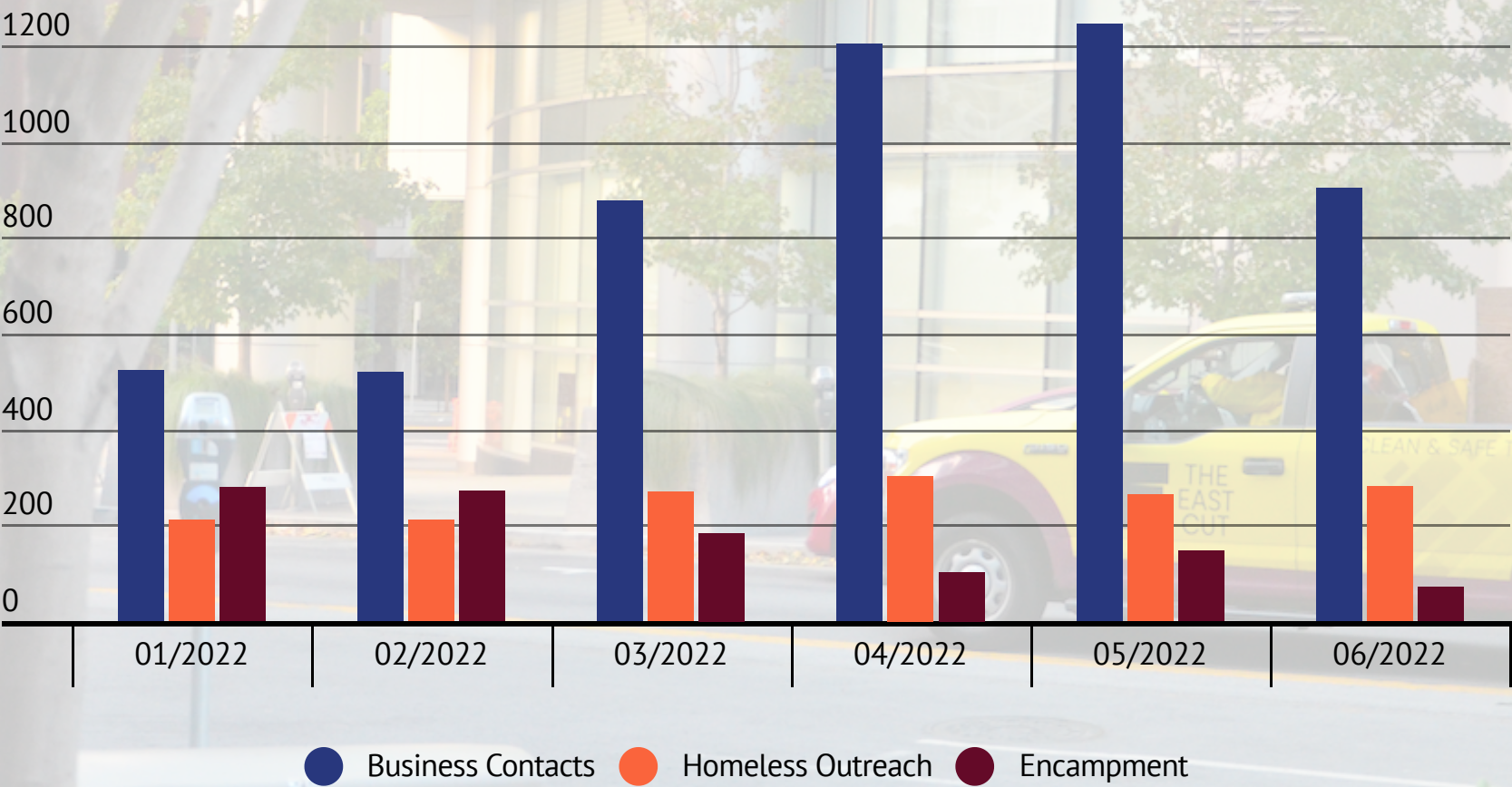

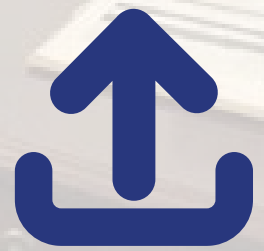
