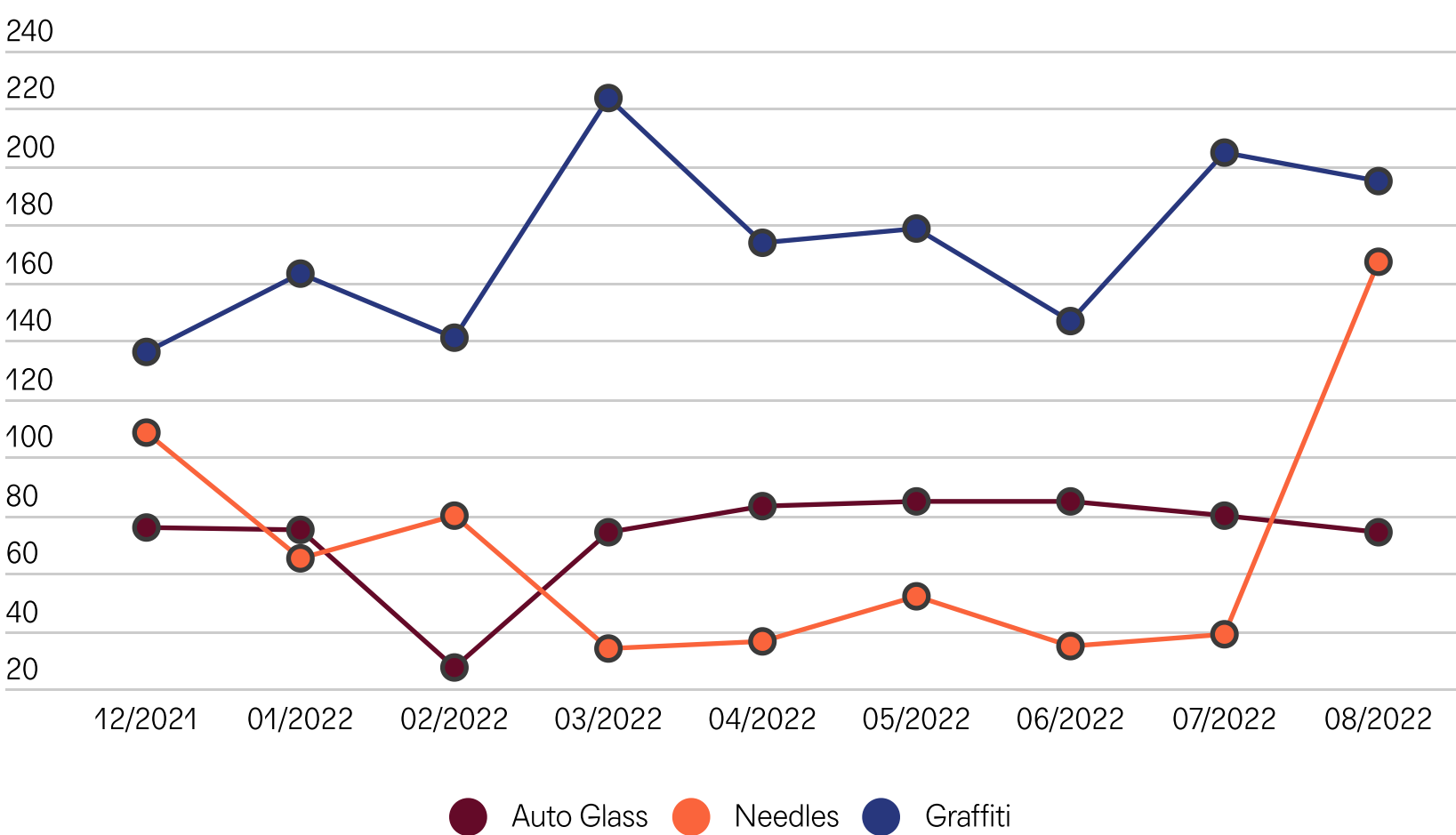

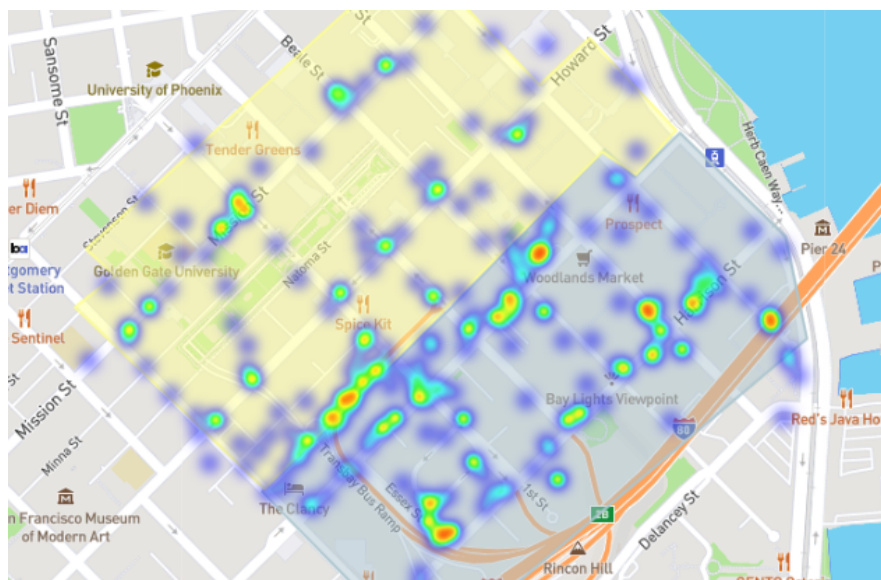
# Quality of Life Cleaning

This map shows all of the feces removed by The East Cut cleaning team. The areas in red require more clean-up.

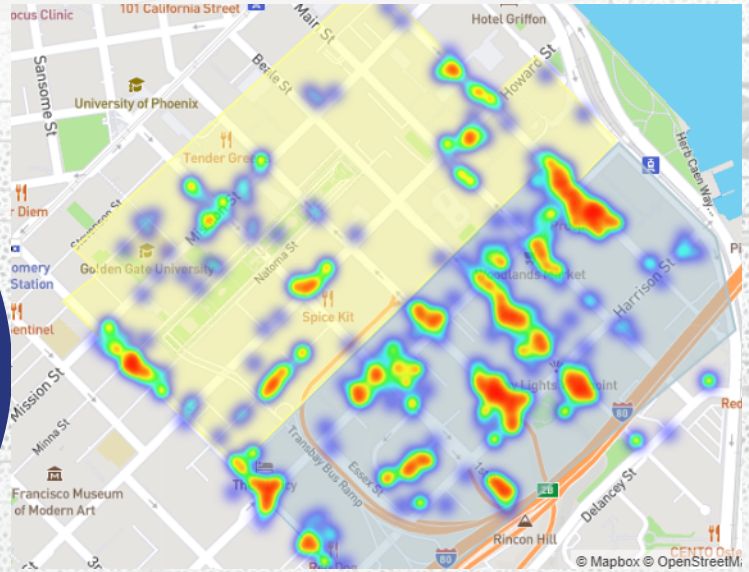

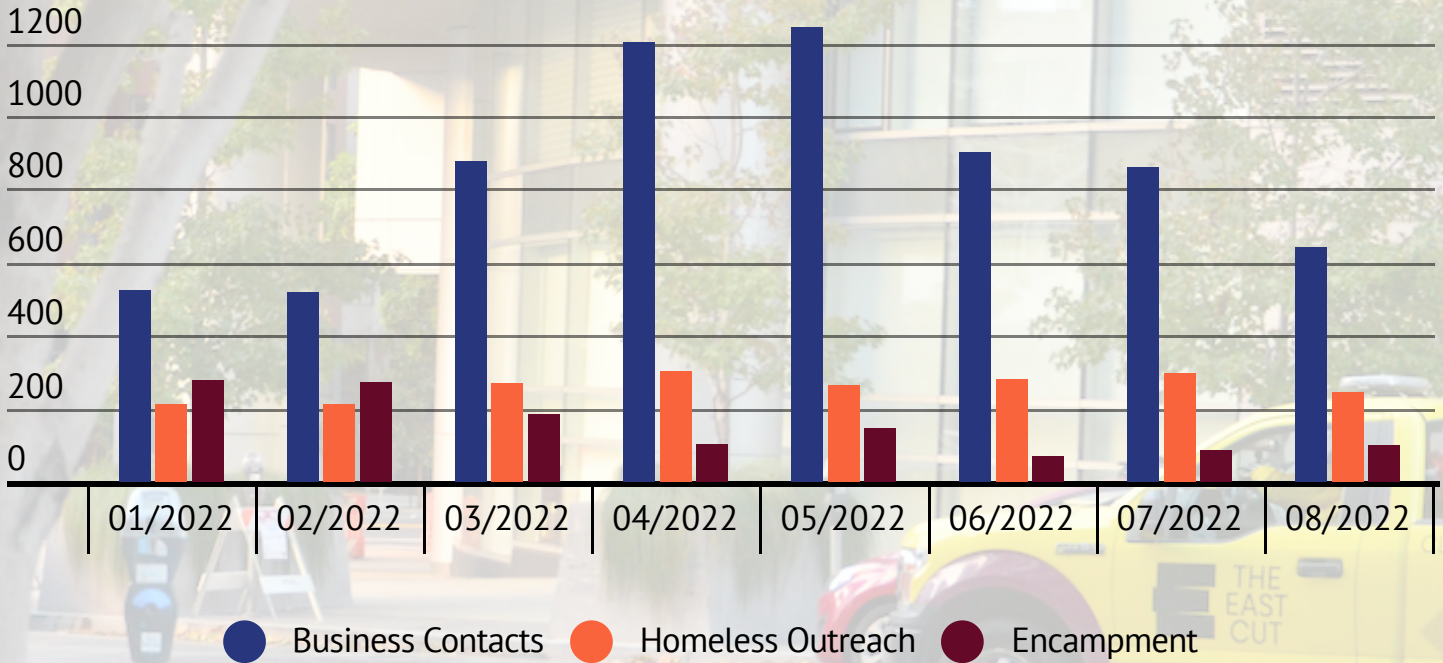
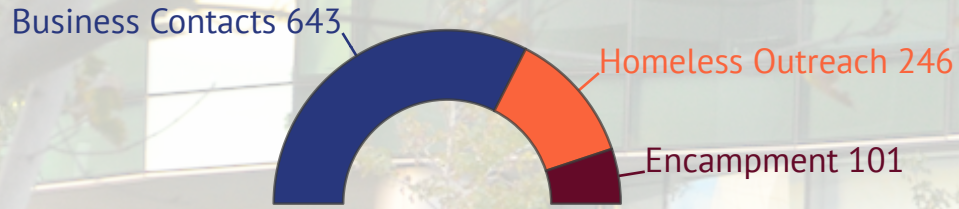


The Crossings located at 200 Folsom St had an individual blocking the front door entrance. The East Cut overnight services team was able to speak to the person and the individual left the area.

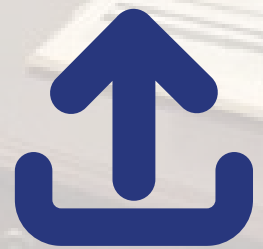

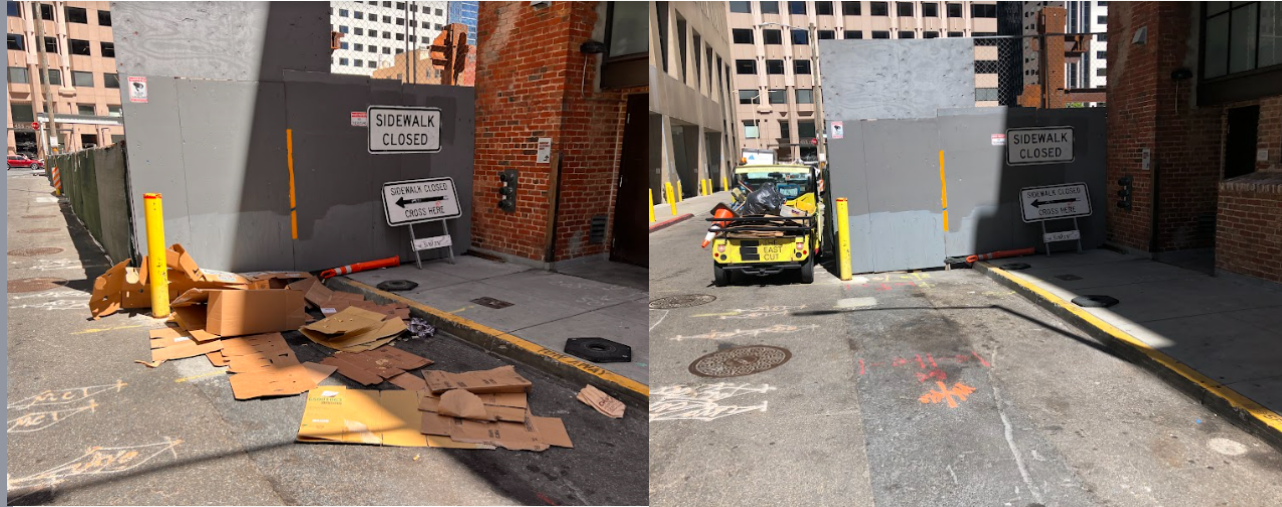

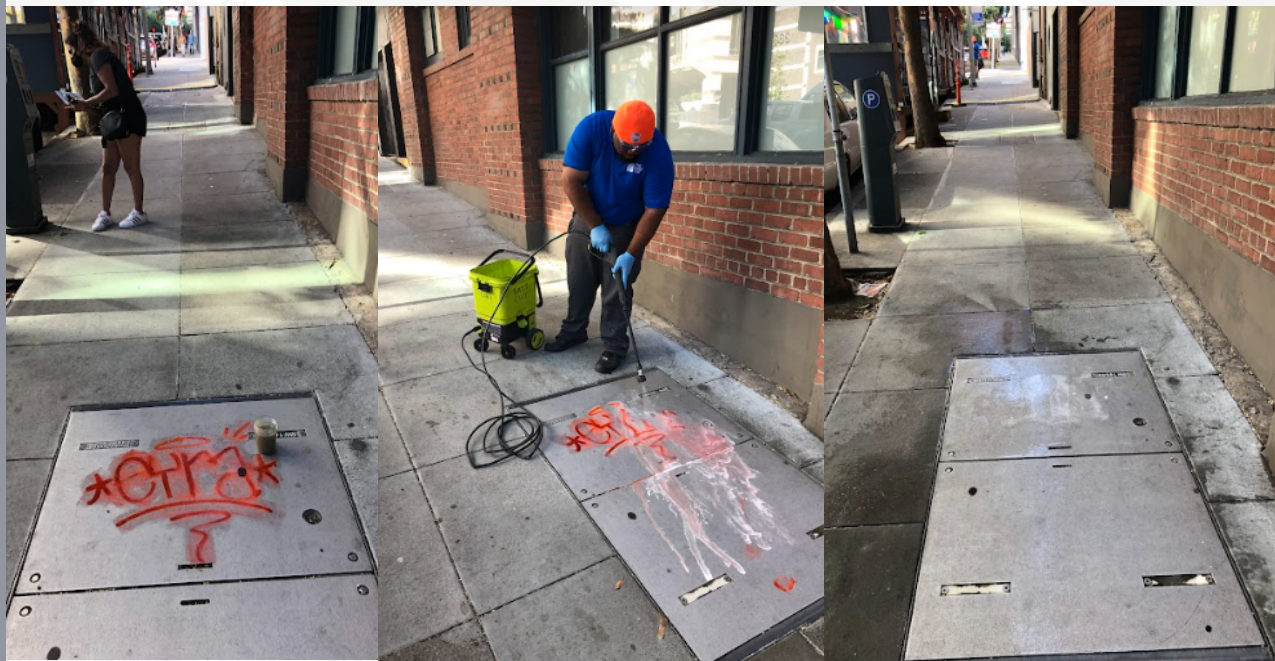
