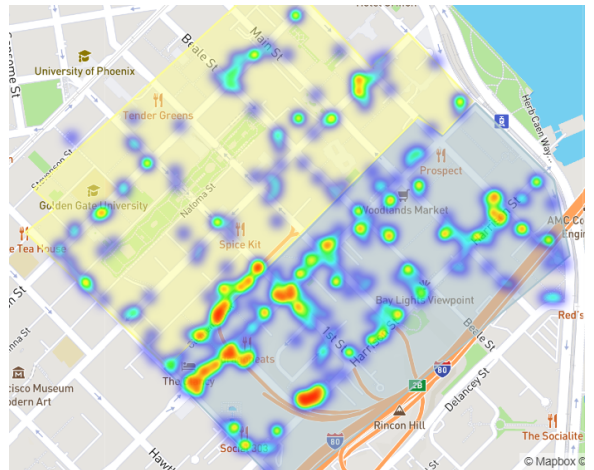


Auto Glass Needles Graffiti

This map shows all of the feces removed by The East Cut cleaning team. The areas in red require more clean-up.

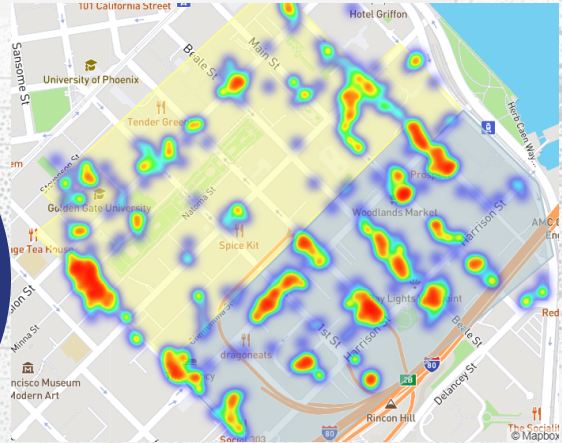
