

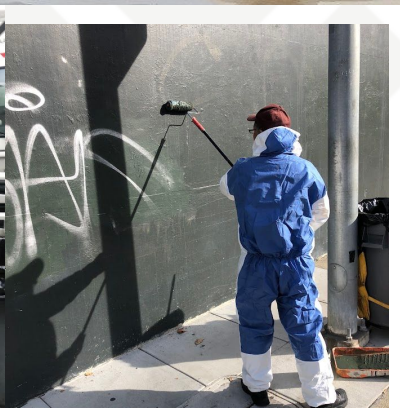

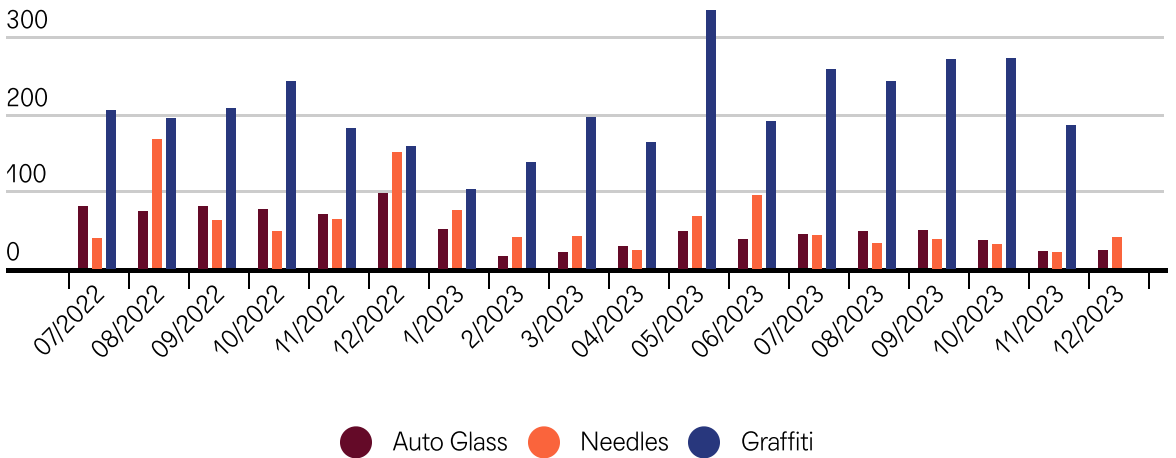
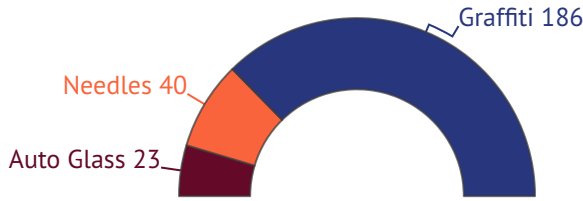

The Essex wall between Harrison and Folsom often gets graffiti tags, but the services team is quick to paint or remove it promptly.

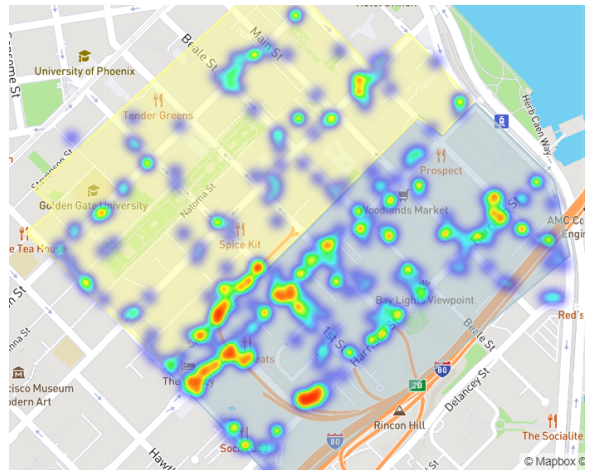

This map shows all of the feces removed by The East Cut cleaning team. The areas in red require more clean-up.

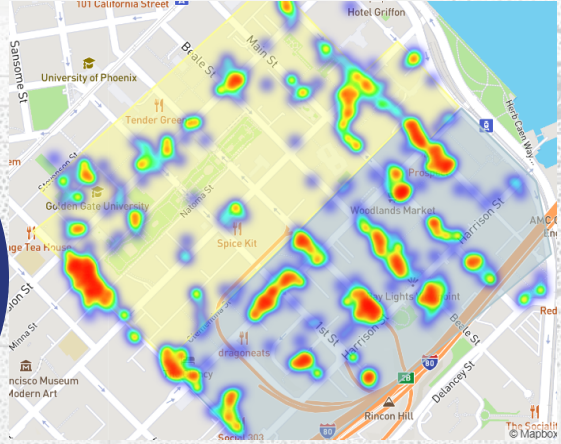
